### Rule #21 - Worker Points

*A rider that works an enduro will receive first place points in their class for that event. For purposes of assigning Overall points, it will be the rider's best finish in events for that season. A rider is eligible to receive worker points for only one (1) event per season.*

*The definition of "working" an event is left to the discretion and judgment of the club / promoter. Permission to work the enduro must be granted by the club / promoter, and the Enduro Chairman must receive a letter from the rider prior to April 1st stating the enduro to be worked. If a rider is approved and scheduled to work an event for worker points, but rides the event instead, the rider will not receive any points for the event.*

*Upon approval of the club / promoter and Enduro Chairman, a rider may be allowed to work on and ride very limited sections of the event trail, representing no more than 20% of the overall course length, and still be eligible to race the event and receive series points. In this situation, the rider will not receive worker points, may not track mileage for any portion of the course, may not ride the entire course, nor become aware of any check placements. The rider's points for the event will be removed if there is a protest filed and it is determined by a majority decision of the Event Chairman, Event Referee, and Enduro Chairman that there has been any breach of these restrictions.*

*The Points Keeper will confirm with the club / promoter after the event that all worker requirements have been met prior to awarding points.*
